Hotel Encanto Prepares for Spaceport America Astronauts As Virgin Galactic Selects Resort as a Preferred Partner

Virgin Galactic has selected Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces as the official preferred Virgin Galactic hotel and resort in Dona Ana County. The luxury hotel based in Southern New Mexico, is managed by Heritage Hotels & Resorts, Inc. and has undergone a series of large-scale renovations and upgrades over the past year in order to meet the needs of Virgin Galactic executives, Spaceport America Astronauts and their families.

To underline this commitment, Hotel Encanto is undergoing improvements and renovations of several rooms at the hotel by remodeling them into Executive Suite VIP Wings. Guests in the Executive Wings will experience VIP concierge service, private VIP areas, customized room service menus, and upgraded first-class rooms and suites. These hotel guest rooms are being remodeled with upgraded finishes throughout, marble clad bathrooms, custom cabinetry, and artisan built furniture, designed by Adriana Long.

"The new Virgin Galactic guest room design reflects the culturally rich style of Hotel Encanto along with an adventurous and contemporary attitude. The design will be timeless and luxurious," explains Adriana Long, designer.

Additional hotel renovations include adding additional poolside terrace rooms and outdoor spaces. The area includes terraces, balconies, fire pits and fountains built out of old world stone accents, providing over 2,500 square feet of updated and newly added additional space for private functions and VIP gatherings. The hotel also remodeled its nightclub patio, which was designed by interior designer Adriana Long. The new Azul Ultralounge now includes a large, contemporary outdoor patio with luxury contemporary furnishings.

About Virgin Galactic

Virgin Galactic, owned by Sir Richard Branson's Virgin Group and aabar Investments PJS, is on track to be the world's first commercial spaceline. To date, the company has accepted more than \$70 million in deposits from approximately 580 individuals, which is approximately 10% more than the total number of people who have ever gone to space. The new spaceship (SpaceShipTwo, VSS Enterprise) and carrier craft (WhiteKnightTwo, VMS Eve) have both been developed for Virgin Galactic's vehicle fleet by Mojave-based Scaled Composites. Founded by Burt Rutan, Scaled developed SpaceShipOne, which in 2004 claimed the \$10 million Ansari X Prize as the world's first privately developed manned spacecraft. Virgin Galactic's new vehicles, which will be manufactured by Virgin Galactic in Mojave, Calif., share much of the same basic design, but are being built to carry six customers, or the equivalent scientific research payload, on space flights. The vehicles will allow an out-of-the-seat, zero-gravity experience with astounding views of the planet from the black sky of space for tourist astronauts and a unique microgravity platform for researchers. The VSS Enterprise and VMS Eve test flight program is well under way, leading to Virgin Galactic commercial operations, which will be based at Spaceport America in New Mexico.

About Spaceport America

Spaceport America is the first purpose-built commercial spaceport in the world. The launch complex, situated on 18,000 acres adjacent to the U.S. Army White Sands Missile

Range in southern New Mexico, has been providing commercial vertical launch services since 2006. Spaceport America has hosted 20 vertical launches thus far. The New Mexico Spaceport Authority continues to work closely with tenants Virgin Galactic and SpaceX, along with other flight customers in support of the commercial space industry.
